Incoming mobility of master students/PhD candidates

The [Argus European University Alliance](#) brings together the [University of Bergen](#), the [University of Granada](#), the [University of Graz](#), the [University of Leipzig](#), the [University of Padua](#), [Vilnius University](#), the Université Lyon 1, the Université Lyon 3 and the Université de Saint-Étienne, all longstanding comprehensive research universities.

PURPOSE OF THE CALL – INCOMING MOBILITIES

Thanks to a funding of the *Agence Nationale de la Recherche* (ANR) and of the Arqus programme, this call will facilitate the hosting in Lyon – Saint-Étienne of early stage researchers (master's students or doctoral candidates) from one of the Arqus partner universities for medium- to long-term internships.

The involvement of supervisors from at least two Arqus partners is imperative, as co-direction of research is a key feature of the scheme.

The internship must be carried out until 30 September 2022.

ELIGIBILITY

Master students from all fields of research are eligible, as long as they are registered at one of the Arqus partner universities

Doctoral candidates from all fields of research are eligible, as long as they are attached to a laboratory hosted by one of the Arqus partner universities.

Locally, the internship must be carried out with supervisors hosted in a laboratory/research unit under the main supervision of the Université Lyon 1 or Université Lyon 3 or Université de Saint-Étienne.

FUNDING

The flat-rate funding of €1000/month for the internship is intended to contribute to the research costs.

Internships of a minimum of three months and a maximum of six months can be funded.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- The call is open until 15 April 2022.

- Applications will be received and processed on a rolling basis. A rapid response will be given.

The selection board will reserve the right to evaluate the number of participants and the duration of the internships according to the budget available.

The selection of applicants is based on the following criteria:

- ✓ The involvement of supervisors from at least two Arqus partners is imperative
- ✓ Quality of the proposal, aims and objectives
- ✓ Joint research interest in the proposed topic
- ✓ Research area with substantial overlap between the two universities
- ✓ Balance in terms of duration of the internship and hosting laboratory
