


Organisation of research support services

- Central administration offices with dedicated responsibilities
 - Division of Research and Innovation
 - Division of Finances
 - etc
 - UiB Research Support Team
- Division of work
 - Local support (faculty and Dept): The Research Council of Norway, other
 - Central admin support: Horizon2020/Europe, Center and Infrastructure projects
 - Always in close collaboration with local support team
 - Flexible solutions


UiB Research Support Team

Establised as a matrix team of 40+ people to coordinate and develop research management services across 7 central administrative divisions, supporting both faculty and departmental administrations as well as individual researchers.



Support team tasks

- Supports research, innovation and education projects
- Develop toolbox for researchers and support staff
- Provides training through internal support staff training programme <u>UiB Opp</u> (UiB Up)
- Support faculties and individual researchers in all phases of projects
- Targeted, specialist competence thorugh Expert Team



Expert Teams

The UiB Research Support Team is organised into *Expert teams* for specific funders and programmes

- One Local Contact Point (LCP) for all programmes (mimics NCP organisation)
- LCP is UiB hub for information-Flow
- Dynamic teams
- Targeted support- Experts from all relevant areas
 - Example: EU MSCA PD
 - Proposal support
 - International recruitment and mobility
 - Career development
 - Online visibility, communication activities
 - Budgeting and financial reporting
