### Final Conference of the Bologna With Stakeholders' Eyes For a Future of the Bologna Process (BWSE FORward)

25th May 2022, Paris, France

The **BWSE FORward – Bologna with Stakeholders Eyes for a Stronger Future of the Bologna Process** project is an Erasmus+ Programme funded initiative aiming to support the implementation of European Higher Education Area (EHEA) reforms. The coordinator of the project is the European Students' Union (ESU) whose vision throughout this project has been to put into practice more trust-based cooperation amongst the crucial players of the higher education system (including governments, quality assurance agencies, ENIC-NARIC centres, local authorities, higher education institutions and student governments) who need to work hand in hand in order to address the various challenges in EHEA countries.

The first objective of the project was to update the latest version of '[Bologna with Students' Eyes publication \(2020\)](#)'. Based on the results of the Bologna with students' eyes (BWSE) publication and the outcomes of two Peer Learning Activities (PLAs), a set of recommendations has been drafted on the main issues identified by students in the EHEA:

- student participation in quality assurance
- student-centred learning
- implementation of ECTS
- recognition of prior learning
- internationalisation and mobility

As the project draws to an end, on the **25<sup>th</sup> of May 2022**, ESU in partnership with the European Association for Quality Assurance (ENQA), the European University Association (EUA), the European Association of Institutions in Higher Education (EURASHE), the Malta Further and Higher Education Authority (MFHEA) the Ministry of Science and Education of Croatia (MSE), the Ministry of Education and Science of Armenia (MoES) and, as Associates, the European Quality Assurance Register for Higher Education (EQAR), will be hosting the **Final Conference** of the BWSE FORward project in **Paris, France** in conjunction with ESU's 82<sup>nd</sup> Board Meeting bringing together ESU's Executive Committee, full member and associate member organisations. The event is open for anyone who wishes to participate.
